# **THIS WEEK**

RON LAW, Director of the Carolinas Concert Association, was our speaker this week. He told us that this year is the 75th Anniversary of the group, and that six productions, rather than the normal five will be produced during the season.

The final production of the 2004-2005 season will be a mixed media performance featuring the music of Tuscany, Italy.

The 2005-2006 season will begin October 9 with a performance by the Zurich Chamber Orchestra. On November 7, the Munich Symphony Orchestra will perform. These will be followed up in 2006, with performances by the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra on January 17, pianist Olga Kern on February 7, and the Russian National Ballet on March 13.

The group is particularly interested in fostering an interest in classical music among youth. It regularly allots 200 tickets for performances to children who otherwise would not be able to attend. In addition, each year they purchase around \$10,000 worth of musical instruments for music students in area schools. The Association is currently trying to raise \$5,000 to help the Albemarle high school band which recently lost 75% of its musical instruments in a fire. The group is an associate member of the Charlotte Arts & Science Council, but does not receive funds from the council.
