DON JONAS, of the Foundation of the Carolinas, was guest speaker at the first of our two April meetings.

He told us that the Foundation was started with a \$3,000 gift in 1958. The first such organization was founded 90 years ago in Cleveland, Ohio. The group serves as a catalyst. for philanthropic giving in a 13 county area surrounding Charlotte. Ten of the counties are in North Carolina and three are in South Carolina.

The group currently is managing philanthropic gifts totaling \$4 million. Throughout its history it has made an average \$2 million donation to the city. The group is comprised of legal and other professionals

DON advised that the minimum amount that could be handled by the group was \$10,000, and that the organization generally charged a 1% commission.

The foundation is pledged to protect the donor's intent and is now prepared to track the results of gifts that are under their control.
