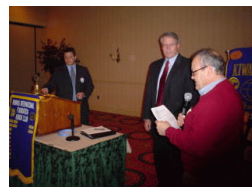

By 1918 membership had reached 10,000. A two-room headquarters office is opened in Chicago, managed by O. Sam Cummings, first International Secretary. At the Birmingham, Alabama convention in 1919 the squabble between the two factions came to a head. Allen Browne still owned the organization. Dissidents prevailed and proposed to buy Browne out. He named his price: \$17,500. Within one hour that sum had been subscribed, Allen Browne was paid off, and Allen Browne was gone!
