The Carolinas District has a policy - established in the 1930's and never violated - of rotating the governorship annually among three regions: Western North Carolina, Eastern North Carolina, and South Carolina. But with the lack of a 2007 candidate for Governor-Elect from Eastern North Carolina, the District Board has approved - for this year only - allowing a candidate from South Carolina. David Vaughan, from Darlington, has indicated his intention to run.
