The International Board of Trustees is composed of an International President, President-Elect, Vice President, Immediate Past President, and 12 International Trustees. Trustees are elected for three-year terms, and are not eligible for re-election; while Officers serve for one year only. The only constitutional requirement for candidacy for International office - other than being a member in good standing of a Kiwanis Club in good standing - is that the individual must have served as a District Governor. To be sure ALL parts of the world are represented on the Board, there are guaranteed Trustee seats for certain geographical areas. These Trustees are elected by their own regions, rather than at large by an International Convention. In addition, the International Executive Director is automatically a member of the Board.
