From over 200 such applications, we were not chosen as "the one." So, for us, it's back to the drawing board. Where do we go from here?

Mark Mogul recently related to us some details of this charitable fund and suggested that we might find benefit by partnering with it. So he arranged this program to tell Club members about it, and how we might be able to continue and expand our Pediatric Cancer program in a mutually beneficial association with them..
